## Facilities

### Workshop:

## Library:

## Hostel:

There is campus hostel facility for the accommodation of the students which is mandatory from classes VI onwards. Each room is equipped with good quality furniture and students are provided with individual study table, lamps, bed, cupboard etc., along with this students also have the facility of RO system & geysers. No efforts have been spared to make the children comfortable.



## Hostel Rules:

1. In case of medical problems of hostellers, only First-Aid will be provided by the college.
2. All hostellers are expected to follow the rules and code of conduct applicable to the proper uniform, class room attendance and appearing in the examinations.
3. All hostellers are encouraged to make the best use of the excellent infrastructure and furniture provided to them in the hostel and also protect it from damage. Careless breakage or damage is likely to lead to penalty, the nature of which shall be decided by the disciplinary committee along with the Principal.
4. It is compulsory to stick name tags on every belongings of your ward including uniform.

5. Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM) shall be held in each term as given in PTM Schedule. It is mandatory for all parents/local guardians to attend these meetings in order to be fully acquainted with the progress being made by their ward.
6. Leave for visiting the local guardian or for going out of the college premises for any reason, leave must be taken from the warden to avoid disciplinary action.
7. All details related to medical history, if applicable, must be submitted to the warden to enable timely and appropriate medical care.
8. Check diary whenever you visit the college or child goes home.
9. Communication from home will not be allowed in any case.
10. If your ward is found with mobile or any other electronic gadget, T.C. will be given. Mobile or any other electronic gadget will not be refunded in any circumstances.

Excursion and educational tours to various places are organised by the school every year as an extracurricular activity respectively for both the Primary Wing and the Senior Wing, to explore knowledge pragmatically what they have been taught in classrooms.

The school has provision for well equipped vocal music, instrumental music and dance in its campus where the students are trained in various forms of performing art in music room and classes.



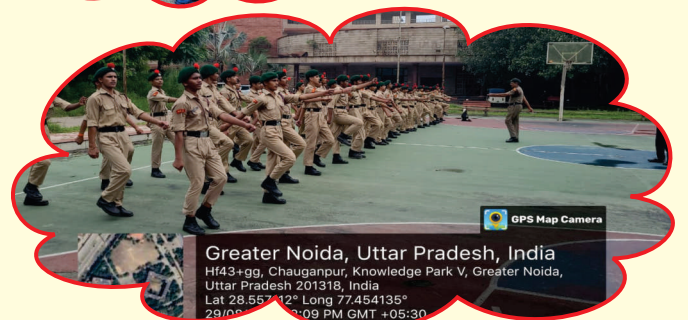
## Art Room:

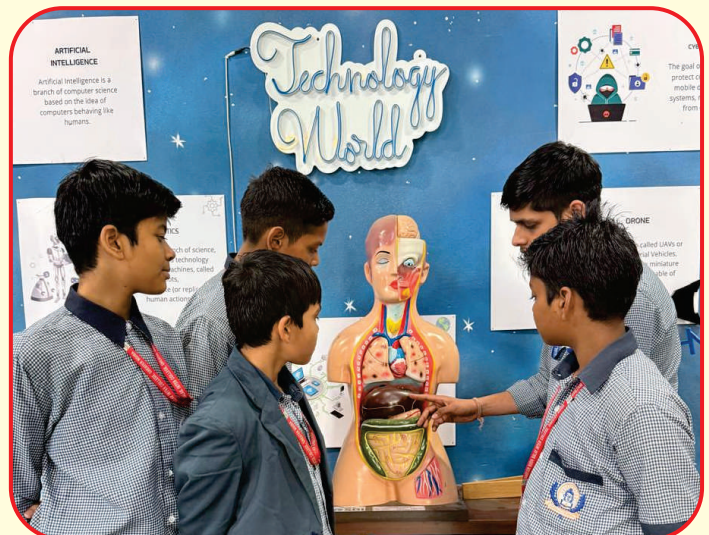

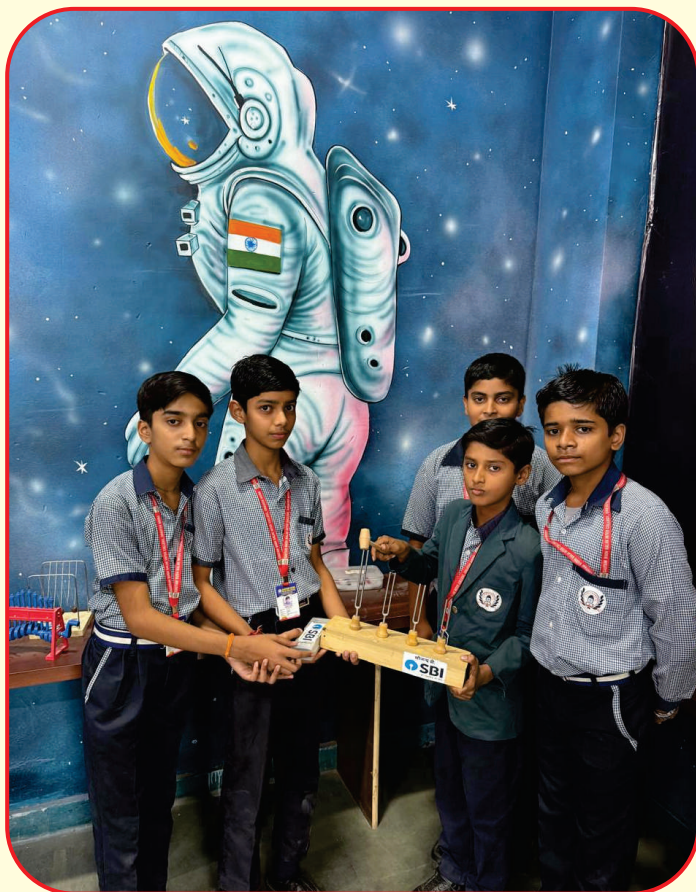
# Aadharshila



Our school has established a unique lab named "Aadharshila," a joint collaboration between The State Bank of India and the Greater Noida Authority. The inauguration ceremony was attended by distinguished guests, including Dadri MLA Mr. Tejpal Nagar and Greater Noida Authority ACEO Mrs. Prerna Singh(IAS). The new lab features project models, virtual reality (VR) headsets, and interactive activities designed to help students improve their skills in technology, science, and space.







## Sports Facilities (By HCL)

Dribble Academy Foundation (DAF), in partnership with HCLF under the banner of sports for change initiative, has started the High performance center Basketball Program at our school. This initiative is fully supported by HCL Foundation, which has a longstanding relationship with the school. DAF with the support of HCL Foundation provides a dedicated Coach for the school. It also provides Equipment, Merchandise, Nutrition and Basic Support to participate in tournaments. It adheres to all safety protocols, ensuring compliance with the relevant guidelines.





## Sports Activities:

The school facilitates a wide range of sports, and excellent facilities are available for cricket, volleyball, football, and many others. Outdoor courts are available for tennis and basketball.

The vast campus is suitable for sports such as running and trekking. Coaching is offered in various sports, including volleyball, and football. The school's aim is to make sports both fun and enjoyable while developing skills, coordination, stamina, and sportsmanship. Students are also encouraged to take part in expeditions and excursions away from the school for sports purposes.



## Norms & Criterion:

### Eligible Age for Admission

Minimum age for admission in class 1<sup>st</sup> is 6-7 years on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the academic year. For admission to other classes the age will be accordingly increased.

**Note:** An upper age limit for admission is fixed as the minimum age limit + 2 years. There will be no admission in a class if the age is more than this maximum age prescribed.

### For Admission in Class I – IX

For admission in Class I – IX for each academic session, the dates for obtaining the prospectus along with the admission form will be notified only for classes where seats are available. Students seeking admission can obtain the prospectus from the college reception from December against payment of prescribed cost. The application form, duly filled in and signed, should be submitted in the college office in which admission is being sought with the registration fee (non-refundable) before January of the particular session.

On the basis of written test and interview in the subjects – English Maths and Science for classes VI – IX. The test will be of 2 Hrs. This will be held in the college premises wherever the candidate applies. The time and date will be given on the registration card issued at the time of submission of the application form. The qualified candidates will be called for the personal interview along with their parents on dates and timings as specified in the list of selected candidates. The list will be displayed on the college notice board. The candidates selected for admission to the college will have to abide by all the rules framed by the college authorities with regard to the following details:

1. Marks sheet of the last annual examination passed for Classes II – IX.
2. Date of Birth Certificate.
3. Ten passport size photographs for hostellers.
4. Caste Certificate.
5. Domicile Certificate.
6. Medical Certificate.
7. Transfer Certificate.
8. Affidavit (VI – XII)
9. Aadhaar Card

### Admission to Class XI

Admission to class XI will be opened immediately after declaration of board results of class X by CBSE. Last date of the submission of the admission form will be one week after the declaration of the result.



## Documents Required

1. Photocopy of provisional marks sheet of Class X examination.
2. Character Certificate issued by the school last attended.
3. Certificate for achievement in extracurricular activities.
4. Migration Certificate for applicants who have passed Class X examination from board other than CBSE.
5. Caste Certificate.
6. Domicile Certificate.
7. Ten passport size photographs.
8. Transfer Certificate.

**Note:** No fresh admission will be taken in Class X and XII.

## School Session

The academic session commences from 1<sup>st</sup> April to end of March. The college closes for the summer vacations from mid May till 30<sup>th</sup> June. There is a short autumn break in December/January.

## Academic Activities

Our college follows the system of Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) which follows four formative assessments and two summative assessments along with projects and practical. Project based learning has made learning more enjoyable, interactive and meaningful.

The college offers different streams to students after 10th grade:

**Science Group | Commerce Group | Humanities Group**

**Note:** Subject to the fulfilment of students section formation.

## RESERVATION FOR ADMISSION

The reservations for admission in all the four inter colleges shall be as follows:-

1. 50% for General Candidates of U.P.
2. 27% for Other Backward Classes (OBC's) of U.P.
3. 21% for Schedule Caste Candidates of U.P.
4. 2% for Schedule Tribes Candidates of U.P.

**Note:-** 85% of the total seats shall be reserved for domicile of U.P.[35% shall exclusively be reserved for domicile of District Gautam Budha Nagar (U.P.)] and 15% seats for the wards of outside U.P.
